Objectives

The **Seminole Holland Neighborhood Association** is organized to unify us as a neighborhood, and to improve the aesthetic qualities and overall quality of life within the boundaries of the neighborhood. The specific functions the neighborhood association will strive to address include:

- crime prevention
- assisting and supporting neighbors in need
- increasing neighborhood beautification and property maintenance
- working with the city to improve and increase the safety of public infrastructure, property and neighborhood streetscapes
- supporting Holland elementary school
- increasing communication with the residents of the neighborhood and the city.

Neighborhood boundaries

The boundaries of the Seminole Holland Neighborhood Association are defined by Sunshine street on the north, National avenue on the east, Sunset street on the south, and Campbell avenue on the west.

In this area there are approximately 3,000 addresses, with 4,700 residents. There are also about 100 businesses within the boundaries of the neighborhood.

Become a SHNA member

General membership in the Seminole Holland Neighborhood Association is open to all residents, property owners and businesses located within the defined boundaries. Businesses outside the boundaries may become *sponsors*.

For residents and property owners:

For all who live in the neighborhood – or own property within it, but live elsewhere – the annual dues are \$5 per person (with a limit of two people per household). The individuals must be 18 or older, and each get one vote.

For businesses within the boundaries:

For businesses or organizations within the neighborhood, annual dues are \$10, and each business or organization is allowed one vote in the association.

For sponsors:

The association encourages businesses located outside the boundaries to become sponsors. The business logo will be placed on our web site, as well as those donating gifts to the association.
